The NEW IPSC MATCH- 50 round match– April 23, 2016.– Kurt VanHorn had a good turnout!

The first TRSC BUG (Back-Up Gun) Match held Saturday, April 23rd, 2016, is in the books and was a rousing success. The match gave the shooters a chance to shoot “that little gun that is easy to conceal, but hard to shoot.” 31 shooters attended the match, which consisted of 10, five round, Virginia Count stages, so the five shot “snubbies” could compete with the “pocket pistols.” The imaginative stages were based on “real life” (or something like it) scenarios, such as “Standing at the kitchen counter, slicing potatoes,” or “Sitting in your easy chair with the TV remote in one hand and a bag of chips in the other,” and even “Sitting at your desk, phone to the ear, writing notes on a legal pad.” Shooters had to remember the combination to a safe in which their gun was staged... or remove their gun from a briefcase, before they could engage targets, ranging from 3 to 10 yards, which all had to be shot in a specific order. There was a BONUS plate on one stage (at 15 yards) that if hit, deducted precious seconds from your “time plus penalty” score. Some targets were engaged from behind cover or through windows at varying heights (advantage little guys... for a change!). There were plenty of “hard cover” and “no shoot” targets, (including a well-known, and much loved “celebrity” no-shoot), which required careful aim.

Hank Marquardt was the overall match winner and got the job done with a revolver. Dave Nater was a close second with a Glock 42 (.380), and Larry Stokes took the third place honors. Four ladies also competed, with Robin Hawkins taking the High Lady title. All shooters commented on how much they enjoyed the match, and how they “really needed to practice” with that “little gun” before the next match. Many thanks to all the competitors and those who helped set up, take down, and made the inaugural match a great success.

Watch your TRSC calendar and E-mails for the date and gun requirements of the next BUG Match, which may include stages such as “Dirty Hairy,” “Mini Three Gun,” “If I Were a Carpenter,” or “Secret Service,” ...as well as another “Celebrity No-Shoot.” Get some range time in with that little gun and come join in the fun!
