The (BUG) MATCH-50 round match, June 25, 2016. 7:00 am. Registration and Set-Up. Shoot starts at 8:00 am. The first Bug (Back Up Gun) match that was held in April was a rousing success! We had over 30 participants and 10 five-round stages. Many of the shooters commented on the good time they had shooting that little gun that is easy to conceal and REALLY hard to shoot. Our next match will follow the same format, in that all stages will be 5 round strings. Virginia Count, with untimed reloads, so the snubby's and pocket pistols can compete with each other. We saw a variety of guns at the inaugural match, some of which "pushed the limit" a bit of what a Back-Up Gun should be, so for this match (and future matches), we will follow the specs set down in the IDPA rules governing the size of the BUG.

The size rules are as follows:**Semi-Autos: .380 or larger Barrel length 3.6" or less Must fit in a test box measuring 7 1/4" x 5 1/2" x 1 3/8"**
Revolvers: .38 cal. or larger Barrel length 3" or less Must fit in test box measuring 8 3/4" x 5 1/2" x 1 5/8"

Built-in or add-on aiming devices, i.e. lasers are ok, as long as they are **NOT** activated. **No optics.** This match will include the following stages... **Dirty Harry, Chaos, Mozambique Memory Mayhem, and Mini-Three Gun.** This will be a 60 round match (four 15-round stages). If you missed the last match, get signed up for this one. If you shot the last match, you have an idea of what you are in for so, in either case, put in some range time and we'll see you on the 25th!
