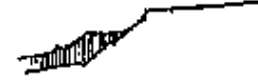

The Back up Gun shoot was held this past Saturday. It was a lot of fun. Kurt Van Horn and Mark did a good job putting it together! We had over 20 people shooting at different scenarios. My favorite was shooting from the shower.. Thanks Guys!

I would like to add a little Range etiquette from our club: Remember that TRSC is a member supported range with volunteers working the various activities and range maintenance. Each member is required to do their part in keeping the range clean and usable. Do not leave trash or used targets on the range. Use the trash container or pack it out. If a trash can is half full, please empty it in the trash collection bins. This is the only area that the Waste Matters truck will pick up trash. Return usable target backers to the box at each range.

Once you have completed your day of shooting, you are required to pick up and dispose of, or pack out your own brass. Bins are located at the different ranges for expended brass. (Brass hounds will be glad to take it from there.)

I also would like to add some safety info: **WHY HAVE A RANGE ORIENTATION ANYWAY ?**

The obvious answer is so you don't shoot each other. But no one is stupid enough to do that. So why have the Range Orientation? Every Member has to have an Orientation to be allowed to become a member of the Tonto Rim Sports Club. You can tell us you are the safest shooter in the United States, but we don't trust you. And there is good reason. On a weekly basis the Range Safety Officers witness "experienced" shooters handling their firearms and those of their friends in an unsafe manner. Fathers and Mothers showing their kids by repeated demonstration how to handle firearms without regard to safety. Who would be stupid enough to teach their kids how to handle firearms in an unsafe manner? But those are only the "Public" right? - Sure -

They are the only ones that accidentally point muzzle in an unsafe direction when loading and unloading. They are the only ones that put their finger inside the trigger guard before they are ready to shoot. They are the only ones that leave a loaded firearm on the bench. They are the only ones that pass loaded firearms back and forth behind each other. They are the only ones loading magazines at the bench while someone is down range, or forgot to unload it, and are now rushing to do that before the person down range gets shot.

The Range Orientation is for the purpose of making everyone that becomes a TRSC member - familiar with the needs required to run a safe Jim Jones Range. Unfortunately it does not include a probationary period of a number of hours enabling observation each shooter as they use the range so we can see if they are worthy to be trusted. Probably the Orientation should be more focused on Basic Safety, because it is obvious that many of our shooters lack that, or just plain common sense. The Range has posted Safety Rules. How often do you read them? Do you even know where they are posted?

Every shooting range has its own rules. From time to time they change. How long has it been since you had your Range Orientation? Can you shoot armor piercing ammo at the Jim Jones Range? What is your obligation if you are the last person to leave the Range? What is the calendar fire season limits at the Range?
