GENERAL MEETING IS HELD AT THE AMERICAN LEGION POST EVERY 3RD THURSDAY AT 7:00pm, 709 E HIGHWAY 260, Payson, AZ 85541

AUGUST GENERAL MEETING will be on August 17th at 7 pm.

RANGE CLOSING: Reminder that when we get a lot of rain the road to the range is not drivable. (You may be able to 4 wheel drive but what you are doing is tearing up the road.) So, when the "RANGE CLOSED" signs are out, do not try to drive to the range. Best idea – call the Range Conditions phone number and find out if the range is open or closed: 480-463-3505. (This phone number is on your membership card in red.)

RANGE ETIQUETTE: Remember that TRSC is a member supported range with volunteers working the various activities and range maintenance. Each member is required to do their part in keeping the range clean and usable. Do not leave trash or used targets on the range. Use the trash container or pack it out. If a trash can is half full, please empty it in the trash collection bins. This is the only area that the Waste Matters truck will pick up from. Return usable target backers to the box at the 100 yard range sign-in area. Once you have completed your day of shooting, you are required to pick up and dispose of, or pack out, your own brass. Bins are located at the different ranges for expended brass. (Brass hounds will be glad to take it from there.)

MISSING STAPLERS: The TRSC has purchased Staplers, Targets and Cardboard Backers for the Members and Saturday Guests. Those Staplers generally get engraved with TRSC or Tonto Rim Sports Club. They are to remain at the Sign-In table. Yes, you can borrow them, but they are to be returned as soon as possible. They are NOT for Discipline Match use. Any Discipline that wants Staplers for their use can purchase them from their Match Supply Funds and mark them with their Discipline Identity. (For instance, the Highpower Rifle Discipline has 3 staplers marked HIGHPOWER, and has them marked that for over 15 years.) Within the last month we have had a time when no staplers were available on Saturday for the Public, even though having over 4 of them marked "TRSC". Our Chief RSO asks that if you have any of those – return them now.

AUGUST "LADIES DAY" : Sunday, August 13th, 9 am. We supply the guns and ammo, the ladies just need to show up (without their husbands). (You can bring your own guns/ammo, if you wish.)

GUNSHOTS OUTSIDE THE RANGE: Recently shots were heard in the forest when the Fire Restrictions were in force (and no shooting was allowed). The question was asked "Who do we contact to report this activity?" You can contact the Forest Service (928) 474-7900 or the Sheriff's Office (928) 474-2208. Do not call 911 unless you are in danger.
